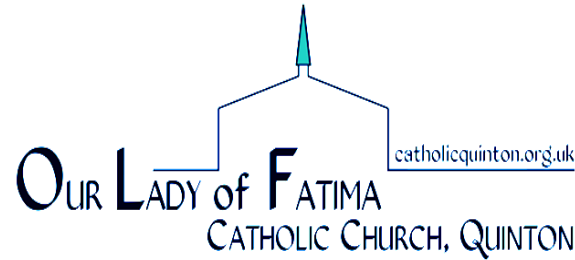

### CERTIFICATE OF CATHOLIC PRACTICE – SCHOOLS ADMISSIONS

**VERY IMPORTANT:** There is one simple criterion for the issue of a Certificate of Catholic Practice and it relates to Catholic practice. Catholic practice equates to weekly attendance at Sunday Mass. This is a fair and good test and means there is a level playing field for every applicant. Therefore, certificates will only be issued to practising Catholics, that is, families who are known to the parish priest and regularly attend weekly Sunday Mass. Occasional absence for sickness or other emergencies, such as extreme bad weather etc are understandable and acceptable, however prolonged absence that has not been notified to Fr Long in advance of a request, means that it is unlikely that he will issue a Certificate of Catholic Practice. Please ensure that you make your application to Fr Long in good time to meet school deadlines (at least two weeks prior to the school deadline) as he cannot be responsible for late applications.

### AND FINALLY,

This Sunday Pope Leo will gather in St Peter's Square with thousands of pilgrims from around the world to celebrate the Canonisation of Saint Carlo Acutis and Saint Pier Giorgio Frassati. Carlo was born in London in 1991 and died in Monza in Italy in 2006 at the age of just 15. It will be an historic moment as Carlo will become the first millennial Saint. Saint Carlo's short life was filled with joy and enthusiasm for the gospel. As we celebrate his canonisation, let Saint Carlo inspire all our young people to discover the riches of his deep faith. **I wish you all a blessed Sunday and a great week ahead. Fr Long Nguyen**
