NOW UNDERWAY: THE SYNOD

The Synod of Bishops started in Rome on Wednesday 4 October, focused on the theme: *'For a Synodal Church: Communion, Participation, Mission'*. The Synod is, for the first time, including non-Bishop voting members, comprising of a number of laymen and laywomen. The Synod is the result of a two-year process which started in September 2021. Catholic faithful and their communities in our Archdiocese and around the world then met in their parishes to discuss the questions posed by the synod. The synthesis of our conversation, and of all the other dioceses in England and Wales, was sent to the Bishops' Conference of England and Wales, who sent their conclusions to the Vatican. Guided by the Holy Spirit, the Synod will help us consider how the Church continues its pilgrim journey in these times, remaining true to the faith handed on to us.
