CERTIFICATE OF CATHOLIC PRACTICE – SCHOOLS ADMISSIONS

VERY IMPORTANT: There is one simple criterion for the issue of a Certificate of Catholic Practice and it relates to Catholic practice. Catholic practice equates to *weekly* attendance at Sunday Mass. This is a fair and good test and means there is a level playing field for every applicant. Therefore, certificates will only be issued to <u>practising</u> Catholics, that is, families who are known to the parish priest and regularly attend weekly Sunday Mass. Occasional absence for sickness or other emergencies, such as extreme bad weather etc are understandable and acceptable, however prolonged absence that has not been notified to Fr Long in advance of a request, means that it is unlikely that he will issue a Certificate of Catholic Practice.

VOLUNTEERS NEEDED

Volunteers are needed in a variety of church tasks, we rely heavily on people's good will, kindness and precious time. We are currently seeking more volunteers and helpers for: Children's Liturgy – Church Cleaners - Flower Arranging – Tea & Coffees after Sunday Masses.

Children's Liturgy: During the 11.00am Sunday Mass in the parish, young children normally have their own liturgy in the hall next door. They re-join the congregation at Offertory.

Flowers: Volunteer flower arrangers have helped to make the parish well-known for its beautiful flower decorations, especially at Christmas and Easter and, indeed, throughout the ordinary season of the year.

Cleaners: The parish church has been blessed with the volunteers who always keep the church clean and tidy. They follow a rota.

Tea & Coffees: To help serve tea/coffee after Sunday 9.00 am & 11am Mass in the Parish Hall and the cleaning up afterwards. You can volunteer on your own and be paired with another parishioner which is a way to meet new people. Or what about considering volunteering as a family group by getting the family involved.
