# SECOND SUNDAY OF EASTER – DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY Alleluia, Alleluia - He is Risen as He said.

Today we continue to rejoice in the gift of the Resurrection of the Lord as we celebrate the Second Sunday of Easter (Divine Mercy Sunday), which is the Octave Day of Easter. The Easter season concludes on Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> May with the Solemnity of Pentecost. Last weekend were delighted to welcome so many people to our parish for the celebration of the Sacred Paschal Triduum and Easter Sunday Masses. They were very blessed celebrations and it was so good to see a full church at most liturgies. We pray that this time of Easter may be a season of renewal and hope for our parish community.



Today is also the Feast of Divine Mercy. Instituted by Saint John Paul II in 2002 the feast celebrates the great mercy of God, inviting us to completely trust in that mercy, and asking the Lord to pour his mercy on us and upon the whole world. The message and devotion to Jesus as the Divine Mercy is based on the spiritual writings of St Faustina Kowalaska, an uneducated Polish nun, who wrote a diary recording the revelations she had received about God's mercy.
