A LENTEN MESSAGE FROM FR LONG

As we begin the sacred Season of Lent with ashes on our forehead, we are reminded that our lives here on earth are merely a journey with an ultimate goal of eternal life which we all share. So, now is the time to assure that we are prepared for that moment when the Lord calls us to himself and judges in love and mercy. Thus, Lent is a special invitation to deepen our commitment to daily conversion so that we are living with in integrity and holiness of life. With the help of our Lord, we achieve this radical transformation through prayer, fasting and almsgiving. First is prayer, reminding us of our complete dependency on God. Secondly, fasting allows us to let go of the things that weigh us down and that we do not need, and to remind us that only God can satisfy the hunger of our hearts. Finally, our recommitment to 'love your neighbour as yourself' transforms our hearts, as we grow in generosity. It is my hope and prayer that this Lent is a source of abundant blessings for all the people of our parish and school and a time of recommitment to the Lord and His call to conversion.

ASH WEDNESDAY (22nd February)

Mass will be celebrated at 10am & 7pm.

It is a day of Fasting and Abstinence – All those 14 and over to abstain from meat. For all adults between ages of 18 & 60 you are required to fast with one meal and only two other light portions during the day. Those outside of these age restriction may of course engage with the fast.
