◊ **Baptisms**: Please complete the request forms and send to the office. You will be contacted to book a date.

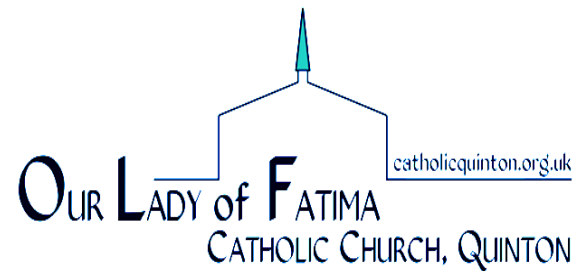

We warmly welcome back Father Long. We very much hope that he has enjoyed his holiday and had some much-needed time with his family and friends in Vietnam. Father Long was able to spend time with the staff and pupils of his charity "A little love scholarship." He wishes to thank all parishioners most sincerely for their valued donations raising £2202.87 and this paid for 44 children to attend school in the new school year. A most worthwhile charity to support because in this country, attendance in school is a right not a privilege. However, in the small villages of Vietnam, attending school is a privilege and many families cannot afford to do this. So please continue to donate to this charity as even a little amount can go a very long way.

Sadly, Mr Roberto Kim Tan Huynh, brother of Fr Long's Mother, died peacefully on 21st August, aged 85 years, may he rest in peace. This means that Fr Long will leave for Philadelphia, in America so that he can celebrate the funeral Mass for his Uncle. Fr Long will leave for Philadelphia on Monday for the funeral Mass on Wednesday and travel back to the UK on Friday 29th August. We send our sincere condolences to Father Long, his Mother and all of the family.

CHILDREN'S LITURGY

Children's liturgy will commence Sunday 7th September. However, please could you take this opportunity to think about whether you would like to support the team in delivering children's liturgy. Everyone on the children's liturgy team must be DBS registered as safeguarding is paramount. In order to run the group, we must always have two DBS registered volunteers in attendance. SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION 2025-2026

First Holy Communion - Catholic children in Year 3 and above can make their First Holy Communion next May 2026. Please speak with Fr Long.

Confirmation - If your child is in Year 6 has not yet been confirmed, they can join the Confirmation Preparation. Please speak with Fr Long.

All forms should be submitted by Sunday 28th September 2025.

The Enrolment/Information session for Reconciliation, First Holy Communion and Confirmation will be held on Friday, 5th October at 7pm at the parish Hall. All parents whose children are in Years 3 & 6 attending non-Catholic schools, who wish to make their sacraments need to attend this meeting and commit to all the sessions required.

CERTIFICATE OF CATHOLIC PRACTICE – SCHOOLS ADMISSIONS

VERY IMPORTANT: There is one simple criterion for the issue of a Certificate of Catholic Practice and it relates to Catholic practice. Catholic practice equates to *weekly* attendance at Sunday Mass. This is a fair and good test and means there is a level playing field for every applicant. Therefore, certificates will only be issued to practising Catholics, that is, families who are known to the parish priest and regularly attend weekly Sunday Mass. Occasional absence for sickness or other emergencies, such as extreme bad weather etc are understandable and acceptable, however prolonged absence that has not been notified to Fr Long in advance of a request, means that it is unlikely that he will issue a Certificate of Catholic Practice. Please ensure that you make your application to Fr Long in good time to meet school deadlines (at least two weeks prior to the school deadline) as he cannot be responsible for late applications.
