◊ **Parish Hall:** See website – there is an enquiry form that you can fill out and send to the parish office website, or telephone 0121 422 4865 to make an enquiry.



19TH JULY "FREEDOM DAY"

As of publishing this newsletter, I have yet to receive new guidance from the Bishops Conference or from our own Archbishop. Until then, I am not sure how the so-called "Freedom Day" will pan out in Churches, although the signs have been very promising.

In the meantime, please remember that we are still in restrictions for this weekend and next weekend 17/18th July, and these must be followed. We should not assume that we are ready to return to everything we had prior to March 2020, especially as we do not know what human resources, we may have available. It will take time to rebuild our social, spiritual, liturgical, and pastoral services and resources which mostly all went into abeyance overnight with the first lockdown.

In addition, many people may well use their freedom to be away from the parish over the summer holiday period.
