
**Useful Information**

### 11TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Dear brothers and sisters, welcome to Mass this weekend!

Shortly, we will be at the mid-point of the year with the longest day and the Feast of St John the Baptist on 24th June. Even during these months of pandemic, time seems to be going as fast as ever. For the first time in a while this Sunday is a “green” Sunday – that is to say one of those Sundays in Ordinary Time. Of course, there isn’t really such a thing as “ordinary” time, each moment of each day is unique; there has neither been, nor will there be another like it. Each moment is therefore precious – a gift from God.

This weekend (12/13 June) a Pastoral Letter from Archbishop Bernard will be read out at all Masses. The Pastoral Letter is focused on the Diocesan Vision: Unfolding God’s Plan. The Archbishop will introduce the Vision and how we intend to move forward as an Archdiocese over the coming years. As we make a fresh beginning after more than a year of lockdowns and restrictions, our aim is for clergy and the lay faithful to work closely to create vibrant communities of faith, joyful in their service of God and neighbour.
