♦ **Parish Hall**: See website – there is an enquiry form that you can fill out and send to the parish office website, or telephone 0121 422 4865 to make an enquiry.

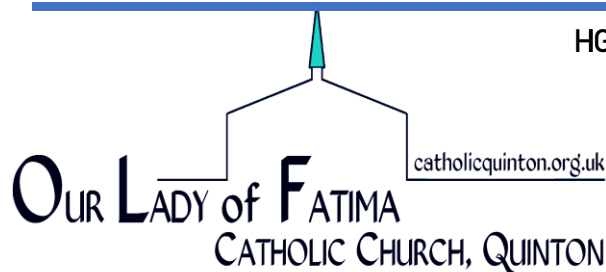

SHRINE OF OUR LADY AND THE SACRED HEART - These lamps burn perpetually at the statues of the Sacred Heart and Our Lady of Fatima. Would you like one of these to burn in memory of a loved one, or for a particular intention? If so, we are asking for a donation of £5 per week, which will go towards the costs of running the sacristy: candles, hosts, wine and other necessities for the celebration of Mass. Please fill out an envelope at the back of Church and hand it to Fr Long. The intentions will be placed in order as they are received and published in the weekly newsletter. The candles are lit from Monday to Sunday.

PARISH FUNERALS - It is a great sadness that the government regulations mean that only 30 close family and friends may attend parish funerals. If you wish to be considered for a place at a parish funeral you must speak with the official next of kin, as named by the Funeral Director, as they will provide the Parish (in advance of the day) a list of approved attendees. Please do not come to Funerals unless they have confirmed that your name has been included on the Formal Track & Trace Form. There are potentially huge fines for breaching the 30 limits. Thank you for your understanding and your prayers for the deceased.

BAPTISM - We are able to celebrate Baptism's with a limit of 6 people. Parents who have postponed their child's baptism due to the coronavirus pandemic should now rearrange a date by phoning the parish office or by email.

SACRAMENTS IN EMERGENCY - For those who are suffering serious illness and those who require the Sacraments of the dying please do not hesitate to call Fr Long. He is unable to make routine sick calls at this time but will of course come to those in urgent situations.

ALTAR SERVERS across the Archdiocese are invited to join the live streaming of the Guild of St Stephen Mass to renew their Guild promises with Bishop William Kenney. The Mass will be celebrated at St Chad's Cathedral at 10am on Saturday 6 March 2021. As part of the celebration servers (young and old, whether at home or in church, vested or not) are encouraged to send a picture of themselves holding their Guild Medal, so the Vocations team can create a montage poster in lieu of the annual official photo at the Mass.
